# Opportunity Overview

*See Me. Hear Me. Cyber Bullying* is an original one-act play, created by American Legacy Theatre as an SEL tool, focused around family miscommunication, youth trauma stemming from isolation, and bringing awareness to career pathways in behavioral health - all to reduce stigma around youth mental health services.

Developed in consultation with Ohio Department of Education and Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, this one-of-a-kind SEL experience is available free of cost to Ohio schools and groups serving high school aged youth.

## Goals and Strategy

The goal of this experience, in alignment with the Ohio governor's prioritization of career pathways and youth mental health, is to demonstrate to high school aged youth the impact of behavioral health on the community. It is a path-broadening and career enriching opportunity that can supplement your current assembly or advisory curriculum. The production also highlights new mental health resources from the state of Ohio as well as provides a social, emotional learning opportunity.

Target Audience:

High School Youth (primary)

Administrators, Counselors, Teachers (secondary)

Goals:

Build awareness of behavioral health career pathways

Build awareness of new Ohio state mental health services [MRSS](#) for youth in support of guardians and schools

Reduce stigma around utilizing mental health services

Increase empathy and social emotional intelligence

Time Commitment (with Students): 45 minutes minimum, 75 minutes maximum

Agenda (with Students):

45-minute performance of *See Me. Hear Me. Cyber Bullying* showcasing the experience goals.

Up to 30-minute facilitated discussion with behavioral health professionals\* and cast (timeframe of this portion to be determined by the school).

# Your Commitment

- **Provide a reliable point of contact** (email and cell phone) of the person who will be American Legacy Theatre's on-site liaison before, during and after the session the day of.
- **Ensure a majority of your high school students attend** this experience to demonstrate the value of their future and mental health.
- **Provide a space** for the performance.

***Space Requirements:** This production is intentionally designed to be flexible to spaces of all kinds. Whether you have a theater, auditorium, gymnasium, lecture hall, or anything in between that can safely seat your students and has electrical outlets for use, the team will make it work.*

## FAQ

### 1. How long will American Legacy Theatre be on campus?

**An overall example timeline is as follows:**

- Load-In / Stage Setup - 45 min to 1 hour
- Performance - 45 min (with students)
- Discussion with Behavioral Health Professionals and Cast - optional, up to 30 minutes (with students)
- Stage Breakdown / Load-Out - 45 min to 1 hour

**Total Time On-Site:**

2.25 hours minimum // 3.5 hours maximum

### 2. How much time do you need with our students?

45 minutes minimum // 75 minutes maximum

*(45 minutes includes performance of play only. 75 minutes includes play and facilitated discussion.)*

### 3. Can we see the script ahead of time?

Once it is done! American Legacy Theatre has been touring another script for the last 18 months, and will debut this original script in Fall 2024 with the approval of OhioMHAS.
